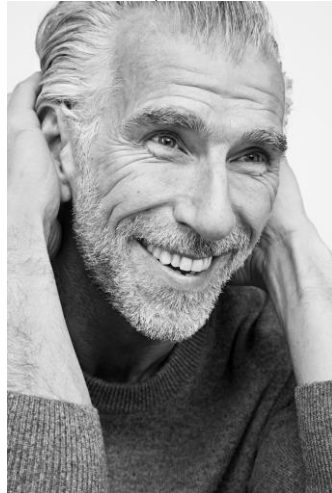


Smart choices for everyday healthcare

Regulatory Affairs Manager Nordic

The Regulatory Affairs Manager Nordic is responsible for the regulatory Affairs in the Nordic Affiliates of Karo Pharma. Accountable for local regulatory execution of strategies and compliance for a defined portfolio which includes pharmaceuticals, cosmetics, food and medical device. Overall responsible for a local nordic portfolio of cosmetics and food together with affiliate colleagues in other Nordic countries. This role is directly reporting to the Global RA CHC with a dotted line to Global RA Pharma.

Roles & Responsibilities:

As Nordic Regulatory Affairs manager you are responsible for local execution of regulatory compliance and strategies in the region for a portfolio consisting of pharmaceuticals, cosmetics, food and medical devices. You are responsible for local execution of global strategies with impact on the Nordic portfolio ensuring compliance in terms of translations, mock-ups, labeling databases and management of customer specific product documentation.

You are furthermore responsible of a local portfolio of cosmetic and Medical device belonging to the so called Center of Excellence brands (CoE) in Sweden together with the Brand managers and part of the CoE Brand teams. You have thereby clear influence on the growth in the Nordic region through local product development and local launches.

In the position, you execute regulatory strategies and compliance close to our stakeholders in the commercial organization, the local Health Authorities, Karo's customers/partners consumers and products on the local markets with primary focus on Sweden.

Your work tasks will include, but are not limited to:

- Nordic translations and labelling compliance including mock-up approval
- Nordic Health Authority relationships and management
- Participate in Center of Excellence brand teams and support the Brand managers in product development in compliance with regulatory requirements.
- Support in compliance related requirements from pharmacies or distributors
- To certain extent collaborate with CMOs for product development in compliance with regulatory requirements.
- Manage and/or coordinate updates to local databases such as Liiv, Fass, Felleskatalogen, Farmacafennica etc.

Qualifications and education:

- 5+ years of experience within regulatory affairs from the pharmaceutical, cosmetics, or biotech industry or a regulatory agency.
- Experience with interactions with regulatory authorities.
- Experience with creation of regulatory documentation.
- Experienced in developing regulatory strategies and execution of regulatory procedures.
- Experience of mock-ups review and translations for medicinal products and consumer health products.
- Knowledge of local databases, such as LiiV, Fass, Felleskatalogen, Farmalogg etc
- Knowledge of European and local legislation.
